"New Nuclear Power at the Forefront of the International Energy Debate - Views from the US Enrichment Industry"

The lecture will discuss the prospects for nuclear power in various regions of the world. With Finland and France in the lead, China and India right behind, where does the US fit in?. In particular, Mr. Van Namen will cover where will the uranium and enrichment come from for the next generation of plants. Issues such as nuclear fuel and non-proliferation in countries with emerging programs will also be discussed.

Bob Van Namen is Senior Vice President of Uranium Enrichment at USEC Inc. He oversees the Company's operations in Paducah Kentucky, Portsmouth Ohio, and Atlanta Georgia as well as USEC's worldwide marketing and sales activities. He previously served five years as USEC's vice president of marketing and sales.

Prior to joining USEC in January 1999, Mr. Van Namen was head of nuclear fuel management for Duke Energy. His career at Duke also included seven years in nuclear design and safety analysis.

Mr. Van Namen is a nuclear engineer with over 20 years of experience in nuclear power. He has served in a variety of leadership roles in industry and professional organizations and currently serves on the Board of Management for the London based World Nuclear Association. He served as President of the American Nuclear Society - Piedmont Carolinas section from 1991-1993.

Mr. Van Namen earned his Bachelor of Science and Master of Science degrees at the University of Virginia. He is a registered professional engineer in the state of North Carolina.
