Biography: Mr. Brookmire is manager of the Nuclear Fuel Procurement group at Dominion Energy, responsible for procuring uranium, conversion, enrichment, and fabrication services for Dominion's fleet. He also oversees multi-discipline projects related to nuclear fuel for Dominion Energy's nuclear units. Prior to becoming manager of Nuclear Fuel Procurement, he was responsible for in-reactor fuel performance and overseeing the dry storage projects at Dominion Energy's independent spent fuel storage installations (ISFSIs) at Surry, North Anna, Millstone, and Kewaunee.

Mr. Brookmire has over 36 years of experience related to the procurement, design, fabrication, operation, analysis, testing, storage (wet and dry), and transportation of nuclear fuel. He graduated with a bachelor's degree in Nuclear Science from Virginia Tech and a master's degree in Nuclear Engineering from the University of Virginia.
