Topic: “Evolution of Advanced Nuclear: A look at fuel manufacturing and the evolving advanced fuels and reactors needs”

Biography: Jeff Whitt is Director of Government Services & Advanced Reactors and is responsible for Framatome’s North America focus on advanced reactor technology and increasing engagement with the US DOE and industry to advance the development of strategic US infrastructure and capabilities.

Prior to his current assignment, he was responsible for facilitation of strategic business development for the Fuel group, which included projects such as Accident Tolerant Fuel (ATF) and the introduction of advanced fuel products, and was named an officer of the Enfission joint venture that was created for the purpose of deploying the Lightbridge advanced metal fuel for the LWR fleet.
